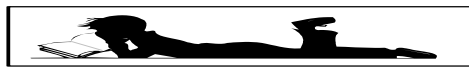


# GRADE 1-2

4. A head start in the Scholastic Reading Program

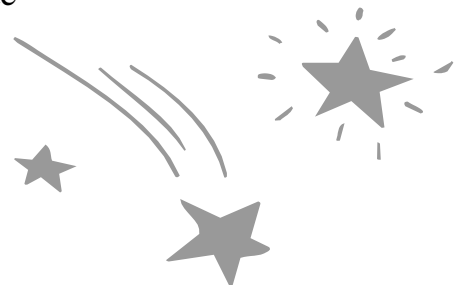
