## **Growly Books by Philip Ulrich**

For Summer Reading for Grades 2-4, we are requiring students to read <u>Widewater</u>, the second book in the Growly series. 1st Graders will have their parents read aloud to them from the first book, <u>Begin</u>. The books have been ordered if you paid in advance and will be available for pick up at the school. They are also required to read a second book of their choice. Parents, please ensure that the book your child selects is challenging without being too difficult. See below for Grades 1-5 reading requirements.

**Grade 1**: 2 books required- Have a parent read the book <u>Begin</u> to you or follow along to the audio version. Then choose another book of your choice to read . Make a poster about one of your books.

**Grade 2:** 2 books required- Have a parent read the book <u>Widewater</u> to you, or follow along to the audio version. Then choose another book of your choice to read. Make a poster about one of your books.

**Grades 3-4:** 2 books required- Read the book <u>Widewater</u>. Then choose any other chapter book of your choice. Write a book review that includes character, setting, and a summary of the plot. Design the review in a way that would persuade or convince someone to read that book.

All Summer Reading will be due the first week of school in August 2023.
